

PORTHPEAN CAMPS

JOB DESCRIPTION: JUNIOR CAMP LEADER

In brief

- Ensure that children of leaders have a full spiritual and activity programme
- Look after junior camp children to enable their parents to be free to work with members

To do what exactly?

- Help deliver a spiritual and activity programme for junior camp to run at agreed times – typically between 09:30 and 17:30 on activity days
- Provide additional supervision when required for children whose parents are otherwise engaged, eg in the kitchen, or on activities
- Ensure safety and risk assessment policies are applied at all times
- Liaise with parents over the particular needs of their children
- Attend main meetings and contribute as appropriate and if requested, remembering that those primarily involved in main meetings will be members
- Liaise with the whole camp team including overall leaders and to be praying for general camp issues

Special Responsibilities of Junior Camp Co-ordinator(s)

- Plan and prepare the junior camp programme, liaising closely with overall leaders, administrators etc
- Have contact with parents and junior camp children in advance of camp
- Give operational and spiritual leadership and support to members of your team

Remember

- Junior camp is an important vital part of camp life, providing a service and forming part of the spiritual programme of camp
- Your relationships with God, junior camp children, the members and other leaders will have an effect on camp

And for everyone

- Your relationship with God will be really important as you serve Him and other people at camp
- Look out for the needs of others and try to care for members and leaders with practical, emotional and prayer support
