

# PORTHPEAN CAMPS

## JOB DESCRIPTION: TENT LEADER

### **In brief**

- Befriend, care for, pray for, offer spiritual challenge to and encourage the members in your tent
- Assist village leaders in ensuring responsible behaviour, but also to ensure that everyone has lots of fun!
- Be a supportive team member, looking out for and caring for other leaders and members

### **To do what exactly?**

- Pray for and contact the members in your tents before camp
- Lead Quiet Times in your tent – and to **thoroughly** prepare for these **before** camp
- Make time to chat to your members - get to know them and find out where they are spiritually and how they're responding to camp
- Sleep in the same tent as the members – going to bed at the same time as them
- Sit with your tent members at most mealtimes and evening meetings
- Join in with members on activities and ensure that no-one is left on their own
- Take on other camp jobs, as required and to lead by example in group tasks, washing up etc
- Assist village leaders in ensuring that your tent has a sensible balance of security, safety and some discipline, eg bedtimes, getting up, tent tidying, but also to have fun with the members
- Keep in touch with and pray for your tent members after camp

### **Remember**

- You are the most important contact for your members: your relationship with God and to camp will be a key aspect of their time at Porthpean

### **And for everyone**

- Your relationship with God will be really important as you serve Him and other people at camp
- Look out for the needs of others and try to care for members and leaders with practical, emotional and prayer support
