

# **PORTHPEAN CAMPS**

## **JOB DESCRIPTION: VILLAGE LEADER**

### **In brief**

- Responsible for the physical, emotional and spiritual welfare for tent leaders and members in your village
- Responsible for activities your village are doing
- Take a general role in camp leadership - looking out for other people

### **To do what exactly?**

- Pray for your members and leaders, before, during and after camp
- Contact the members and leaders in your village before camp - to build relationships and prepare activities
- Hold a daily meeting with your leaders to discuss and pray about village and camp life
- Take responsibility for members who are having or causing difficulties
- Support and substituting for tent leaders in any practical roles if they need a break – particularly supporting Quiet Times
- Have special concern for any special needs of members identified in advance or evident whilst on camp
- Ensure safety and risk assessment policies are applied at all times
- Ensure the village is in the right place at the right time (meals, activities, meetings etc) with regular 'head counts' at these times
- Ensure (with tent leaders) that there is a sensible amount of discipline over, eg bedtimes, getting up, tidying tents etc

### **Remember**

- Your role is to create a Christian family feeling where all are accepted and belong: your relationship with God and to camp will have a big effect on all members of your village

### **And for everyone**

- Your relationship with God will be really important as you serve Him and other people at camp
- Look out for the needs of others and try to care for members and leaders with practical, emotional and prayer support
